

Route Restriction Report

The following temporary restrictions are based on the information available at the time of preparation. They are provided solely as a public service. Actual conditions may vary from those reported.

Date: 01/03/2019

US14/US83/SD34 Missouri River Bridge at MRM 228.35 between Pierre and Fort Pierre - **No Overweight Loads** - until further notice. The overweight detour route will be SD 1806, SD 204 and SD 1804 across the Oahe Dam.

US 18 – MRM 402.77 to MRM 419.82 – From US 81 to SD 19 – **Closed to Traffic** – Highway 18 traffic will be detoured on Highways 44 and 46 – The restriction will be in effect until further notice.

US 18 - MRM 435.25 - US 18W Interchange Exit 59 - **12'- 0" Width Restriction – No Overweight Loads** – Bridge restricted to single lane – Until further notice.

SD 47 - at MRM 89.70 - **No Overweight Loads until further notice** - The bridge is between Big Bend Dam and Fort Thompson over Soldier Creek.

I-90 – MRM 270.14 – 348th Avenue Bridge over I-90 – **Closed to Traffic** – Local road four miles east of Chamberlain not accessible from the Interstate – The closure will remain in effect until further notice.

I-90 – Exit 402 – **Eastbound** On-Ramp and Off-Ramp – **Ramps Closed to Traffic** – The restriction will be in effect until approximately October 18, 2019. Eastbound Traffic will be directed to use Exit 406 at Brandon.

US 183 – MRM 61.0 to MRM 62.0 – 12 miles south of Presho – **ADVISORY** : All trucks and overweight loads advised to take alternate route. Road will have sections of no surfacing due to grading operations.

SD 248 – MRM 145.06 - Bridge Structure #36-136-111 – **7 Tons Per Axle Restriction** - The restriction will be in effect until further notice.

SD 248 – MRM 160.96 - Bridge Structure #36-296-111 – **7 Tons Per Axle Restriction** - The restriction will be in effect until further notice.
